Event Ideas

Outdoor Cleanups

As parks, beaches, and more recreational places begin to open, members can begin to meet at any outdoor setting of their choosing to clean. Members can vote on a preferred location. Make sure your members bring the necessary supplies such as gloves, trash bags, and more!
