EVENT IDEAS

workshops and seminars

Collaborate with other clubs such as American Red Cross, local shelters and senior homes, the Boys and Girls Club, and HOSA (Future Health Professionals). Educate members about COVID-19 and precautions that people that they should take to promote their health and safety during this time. These workshops can be hosted through Zoom or any other video conferencing platform.

active events

Plan different activities, from following exercise videos together through Zoom to holding socially distanced games/friendly competition. Invite your Kiwanis Family, fellow club members, or even other divisions to different active events. Hosting fun ways to get active can promote health and safety for everyone involved, as well as to serve as a way to strengthen bonds.

SERVICE PROJECT IDEAS

psa poster making

Create informative posters or infographics to spread information on how to promote health and safety. Informative infographics can include facts on COVID-19 safety or ways to increase physical activity and improve mental health. These graphics can be posted in the halls of school or on social media.

community clean-up

Go out into your community to help the health of the earth! This can be an opportunity to hold a socially distanced park or beach clean-up service project. Gather supplies and materials, such as trash bags, and gloves, and some key club members to participate in this service project to help the safety of the community.

garden help-out

If your community, school, or home has a garden, it is a great place to promote better health! Not only is it fun to work outside and get fresh air, but it is also good way to get fresh produce and have a healthier lifestyle.

FUNDRAISER IDEAS

make and sell

Make goods, care bears, bracelets, and other items to sell to spread awareness and raise funds to donate. Host a service project to make PTP dolls or first-aid kits to donate directly. Partner with other organizations or clubs within your division as well!

bingo fundraiser

As it is still difficult for clubs to hold food and in person fundraisers, a Bingo fundraiser can be an effective way to raise money. Create a Bingo card with different dares and tasks that will be completed as an incentive for donations and post it to social media. These dares can be anything from cutting hair to health related tasks.
